The Role

We offer unhurried learning opportunities for curious children to engage in learning they love, with prioritised times in nature and a focus on physical fitness, health, wellbeing and creativity.

To a large degree, this position will be tailored to suit the successful candidate's skills and expertise in an educational leadership role, which includes leading a team of educators with complimentary skills to successfully implement the high-quality and innovative educational program (mentioned above). The remuneration and conditions related to the role have been designed to support wellbeing with flexibility in-mind, and are an attractive alternative to a traditional in-school teaching position.
