ELITE ATHLETE SCHOLARSHIPS 2024

Elite Athlete Scholarships at St Philip's Christian College are designed to encourage and nurture talented young sportsmen and women. They are awarded each year to a number of students entering Year 7, Year 9 and Year 11.

These Scholarships are awarded to candidates who demonstrate exceptional sporting ability or potential, and the enthusiasm to make a leading contribution to the sporting life of the College. The number of Academic Scholarships and the reduction of fees offered will vary each year and the College will not necessarily offer scholarships in each category or to each year group. All scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the College Leadership Team.

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Scholarship program is to provide academic, pastoral and financial support to assist our elite athletes in pursuing their unique God-given potential. We want to encourage our students to achieve their best academic results while pursuing their sporting career.

BENEFITS MAY INCLUDE SOME OR ALL OF THE FOLLOWING

- A partial remission of tuition fees.
- Special arrangements with tasks and examinations overseen by the Director of Studies.
- School-based Mentorship overseen by the Director of Sport.
- Travel assistance for Interstate and Overseas competition.

APPLICATION PROCESS

All applications will be considered and parents may be contacted with an offer of an interview.

LENGTH & TENURE OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are offered for a period of two years. Students who obtain a Scholarship in Year 7 will need to reapply for Year 9 and Year 11.

All Scholarships are reviewed annually and the continuation of an award is dependent on the Scholarship holder's athletic performance, academic effort, behaviour, participation and contribution to the overall life of the College.
